As students engage in coursework, the goal is for them to experience deeper personal spiritual growth that will enable them to provide Christ-centered leadership to meet a variety of needs.

- Complete FAFSA and contact Financial Aid at 574.807.7326 if you are seeking federal student loans.

TUITION/FEES

- \$10,500 per year (\$5,250 per semester)
- Students must remain full time to receive this tuition price
- Full time = 15 credit hours
- Practicums have an additional \$30 per credit hour fee.
